The Cum Christo Renewal, is a retreat and can be attended by both Men and Women as often as desired as a candidate or team member. The intent and purpose is to strengthen the faith of the participant and to support, nurture and renew in them their desire to continue in the work as laity in the Catholic Church.

The format is similar to Cum Christo in that it is based on a series of talks, one building upon another. The reflections, Mass, meditations and prayer services are integrated throughout the weekend, as well as the opportunity to receive individual Spiritual Direction and/or the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Simplicity is stressed throughout preparation and during the weekend. Team members are minimal, there are no decorations in the dining room, no palanca, meals are kept simple, and there are no outside visitors. All are welcome to sleep at the facility, although, for those who choose not to sleep at the facility you are welcome to go home each night if you so desire. (For those who come from outside the Billings area you may wish to reserve a motel room.)
